

Introductory Engagement Activity

Aim

To encourage members to think about the big challenges facing Scotland and how Scottish Labour should respond.

Facilitator

Explain the purpose of the session.

Outline the SPF process (see Toolkit).

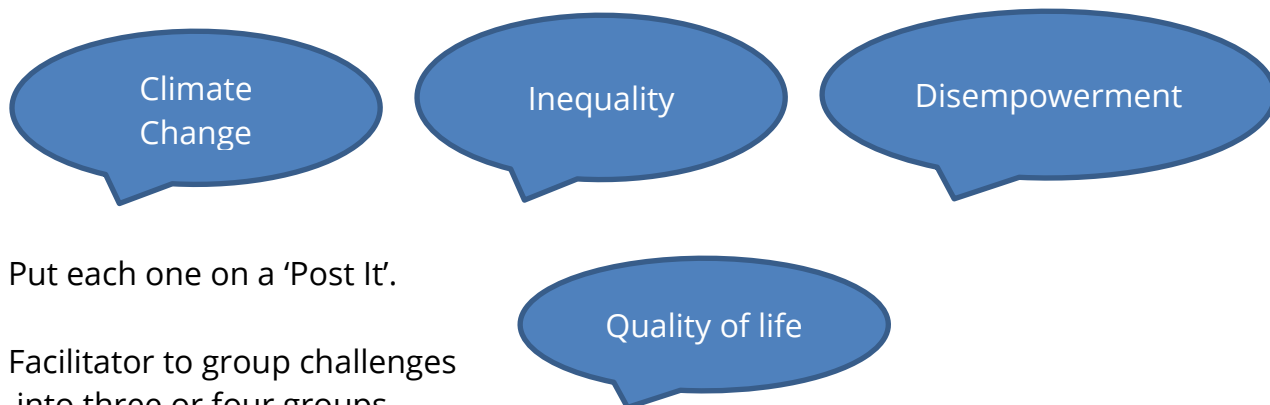
Introduce the SPF consultation papers.

- Challenges, Labour policy and questions.

Questions from the floor.

Activity One

Working in groups, identify three big challenges facing Scotland today. Facilitator to emphasise looking at strategic issues.



Put each one on a 'Post It'.

Facilitator to group challenges into three or four groups.

Activity Two

Take each of the grouped challenges and ask for ideas on how to address them. Looking for short specific ideas, not a detailed policy prescription.

Note on flip chart or ask person to write on a 'Post It'.

Facilitator to clarify ideas, offer factual information, and move discussion along. No idea is a bad idea. Not attempting to prioritise.

Conclusion

Explain the next steps in the consultation process.

Short note of meeting will be circulated.

Ideas will be presented to relevant Policy Commissions.

Members who want to expand on outline ideas – explain how through Policy Hub.
